As directed by and with the blessings of Paramapujya Sri Periyava, a dedicated special Shankara Stotra Course of six months' duration titled **Shankara Stotra Makaranda** has been planned. The course will be



conducted by Jagadguru Seva Ratnam, Upanyasa Tilakam Shri P.R.Kannan. The select list of Shankara Stotras to be covered in the course is given below. The lecturer will recite each verse of each Stotra in parts and the participant will repeat the same. This will be followed by explanation of Bhavartha, essential meaning of the verse, Padaccheda, separation of compound words and Pratipadartha, word meaning. The plan is to cover a verse in about ten minutes.The course will start on Thursday, 28 Jan 2021, followed by sessions on every Saturday and Sunday, each day from 8 AM IST for one hour duration.
